Principal Parpounas and the School Committee are getting ready for our Fall 2020 registration. Registration will take place in the church narthax on **Tuesday, September 15th** from 6:30-8:30pm after the graduation/moving up program which was postponed from last June. The ceremony will also take place in the church. First day of classes will be September 22nd. More information will follow regarding all COVID-19 recovery/reopening requirements, such as social distancing, personal protection interventions which include wearing face coverings, desk spacing.

Children who will be entering Pre-Kindergarten will have to be in Kindergarten in American school and so on. This guideline is set by the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America.

Please contact our Greek School Principal Mrs. Parpounas at 473-0894 for an appointment or see her on Tuesday, September 15th to have your child evaluated and assessed properly. The assessments will take place during registration starting after 6pm. We ask for your cooperation in this matter so that we will be able to provide your child with a positive and proper classroom atmosphere where your child will flourish and enjoy their Greek school experience.

In this mailing is also a registration form as well as tuition payment information. Due to church financial hardships brought on by the pandemic, we cannot accept any hardship applications. ALL Tuition must be paid in a timely fashion for us to budget for the year. No refunds after December 1st. We have Paypal too!
