The Dormition of the Theotokos

The feast of the Dormition or Falling-asleep of the Theotokos is celebrated on the fifteenth of August, preceded by a two-week fast. This feast, which is also sometimes called the Assumption, commemorates the death, resurrection and glorification of Christ's mother. It proclaims that Mary has been "assumed" by God into the heavenly kingdom of Christ in the fullness of her spiritual and bodily existence.

As with the nativity of the Virgin and the feast of her entrance to the temple, there are no biblical or historical sources for this feast. The Tradition of the Church is that Mary died as all people die, not "voluntarily" as her Son, but by the necessity of her mortal human nature which is indivisibly bound up with the corruption of this world.

The Orthodox Church teaches that Mary is without personal sins. In the Gospel of the feast, however, in the liturgical services and in the Dormition icon, the Church proclaims as well, that Mary truly needed to be saved by Christ as all human persons are saved from the trials, sufferings and death of this world; and that having truly died, she was raised up by her Son as the Mother of Life and participates already in the eternal life of paradise which is prepared and promised to all who "hear the word of God and keep it." (Luke 11:27-28)

In giving birth, you preserved your virginity. In falling asleep, you did not forsake the world, O Theotokos. You were translated to life, O Mother of Life, and by your prayers, you deliver our souls from death. (Troparion)

Neither the tomb, nor death, could hold the Theotokos, who is constant in prayer and our firm hope in her intercessions. For being the Mother of Life, she was translated to life, by the One who dwelt in her virginal womb. (Kontakion)

PASTORAL MESSAGE - Rev. Louis Nicholas, Proestamenos

"And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers."
(Acts 2:42)

On the day of Pentecost, St. Luke tells us how, after the baptisms of 3000 men, women, and children, each of them became devoted to *the Apostles*' teaching and fellowship."

The word *devoted* is a very strong word. It means that whatever the Apostles were teaching, this would become the most important thing in the devoted person's life. A person back then would give a certain amount of time, every day, to learn about what the Apostles were teaching. They would make that part of their day solely for learning about Jesus. However, this was only part of their devotion.

The early Church also devoted their time for "the breaking of bread and the prayers." They devoted time for worship. They gave up time during their day to pray each and every day. This is what Liturgy is. To devote some time, and to devote a special place to prayer and worship. To focus only on God. To do God's work. Our work, as God's people, is to be with Him always. This is done mainly through prayer and good works.

"...we ought to think of God even more often than we draw our breath; and if the expression is permissible, we ought to do nothing else", St. Gregory Nazianzen (First Theological Oration no. 5). This powerful image of St. Gregory is what total devotion to God is.

Being devoted to God is hard work. It means to wholly commit yourself to Him, to make Him the most important person in your life. To be devoted to God means to let Him guide you and lead you in everything you do in life. When you devote your whole life to God, you come to realize that God is devoted to you. The best way to begin is through prayer. Taking some time out of your day, every day, to spend time with God is important. It reminds us that God is there.

At our Church youth camps, everyday, the campers spend time to what is called, "Alone With God." Each day the campers stop what they are doing, go off to a private little space, and spend some quiet time being alone. They are told to spend that time talking with God. It can last anywhere from five minutes to 20 minutes. The children will tell you that this is one of their favorite times of day.

Imagine if, every day, you were able to find a few minutes to spend some quiet time doing nothing but being with God. Instead of "devoting" that entire coffee break to a cup of coffee, take half that time to be only with God. Find a quiet place to be alone and talk to God. Try it for one week and tell me how it felt. I promise you it will feel great. I promise you by the end of the week you will find that it makes you feel better and more energized than the coffee. The more time you spend with God the more time you will want to be with Him. One minute, five minutes, or fifteen minutes a day being with God will be a great comfort to you.

Take the time as well to devote yourself to worship, to the teaching and fellowship of the Apostles. Come and devote yourself to God through the Divine Liturgy. Leave the cares and desires of the world behind and be with others who have the same common devotion as you, and worship together. Be with God together and lift each other up through the prayers and become strengthened through the Cup. Come to Church as often as possible and be where God intended you to be, with Him. Use the Divine Liturgy to inspire and revitalize your spirit so that you can go back into the world confident in the fact that God is always with you, and that you can endure anything with Him. Devote your entire self to God and He will show you the way in all things.

"Worship is the norm of Christian existence. It should be the constant disposition or attitude of the Christian man. Indeed, to worship God means precisely to be aware of His presence, to dwell constantly in this presence. It is through worship that the 'new man' is being formed in the believer, and the baptismal grace of adoption is actualized. The Christian man must be always in the state of worship, whether it is expressed in words or not. In its essence worship is the orientation of man towards God", Protopresbyter Georges Florovsky (1893-1979).

Αδελφοί και αδελφές εν Χριστώ,

Διάβασα ένα άρθρο (το οποίο θα το βρείτε παρακάτω) από τον Σεβασμιότατο Μητροπολίτη Δημητριάδος και Αλμυρού, τον κ. Ιγνάτιο Γεωργακόπουλο. Νομίζω ότι είναι πολύ ενδιαφέρον και ελπίζω να σας αρέσει.

«Ο πιστεύων εἰς ἐμέ, καθώς εἶπεν ἡ γραφή, ποταμοί ἐκ τῆς κοιλίας αὐτοῦ ρεύσουσιν ὕδατος ζῶντος» (Ιω. 7, 38).

Μέ μυστικά φίγη συγκινήσεως ὅλοι οἱ ὀρθόδοξοι χριστιανοἱ ὑποδεχόμαστε σήμερα τήν Κυριακή τῆς Πεντηκοστῆς. Υποδεχόμαστε τήν κάθοδο τοῦ Ἁγίου Πνεὑματος. Χαιρόμαστε γιὰ τήν πλημμύρα τῶν θεἰων χαρισμάτων καὶ τῶν ἀπεἰρων δωρεῶν ποὑ κατακλύζουν τὸ σῶμα τῆς Ἐκκλησίας καὶ ξεδιψοῦν τἰς καρδιἑς μας.

Σήμερα ἐπαληθεύονται τὰ λόγια τοῦ Χριστοῦ: «ὁ πιστεύων εἰς ἐμέ, καθώς εἶπεν ἡ γραφή, ποταμοί ἐκ τῆς κοιλίας αὐτοῦ ρεύσουσιν ὕδατος ζῶντος». Πράγματι ὅποιος πιστεύει στό 42

Χριστό, ὅποιος δηλαδή χτίζει μἰα ζωντανή, ἀγαπητική σχέση μέ τό Χριστό μετατρέπεται σέ γάργαρη πηγή ζωῆς καί ἐλπίδας. Ὁ Χριστός εἶναι ἡ αὐτοζωή. Ἀπ' Ἐκεῖνον προέρχεται κάθε πλάσμα καί σ' Ἐκεῖνον καταλήγει. Εἶναι ἡ ἀφορμή καὶ ἡ αἰτία κάθε καλοῦ καὶ ἡ μόνη διόρθωση κάθε κακοῦ. Ὁ Χριστός εἶναι τὰ πάντα καὶ βρίσκεται στὰ πάντα. Εἶναι ἡ μόνη ἀφετηρία τοῦ κόσμου, ἡ ἀληθινή κατεύθυνσή του καὶ ἡ μοναδική ὁλοκλήρωσή του.

Ο ἄνθρωπος πού σχετίζεται με τό Χριστό, πού Τόν ἀγαπάει καὶ Τοῦ χαρίζει τἡν ὕπαρξή του, γεμίζει ἀπό Ἐκεῖνον. Όποιος ἀφήνεται, χωρίς κρατούμενα, χωρίς προϋποθέσεις, χωρίς αἰτήματα στό Χριστό κάνει τἡν ὕπαρξή του φωλιά καὶ κατοικητήριο τῆς Ἁγίας Τριάδας. Μέσα σ' αὐτόν τόν πιστό ἔρχεται τό Ἅγιο Πνεῦμα καὶ ξεδιπλώνει τὰ δῶρα Του. Ο ἴδιος ὁ πιστός γίνεται φορέας τῆς Θεότητας. Γίνεται ἀγωγός τῆς θεϊκῆς παρουσίας μέσα στόν κόσμο. 


